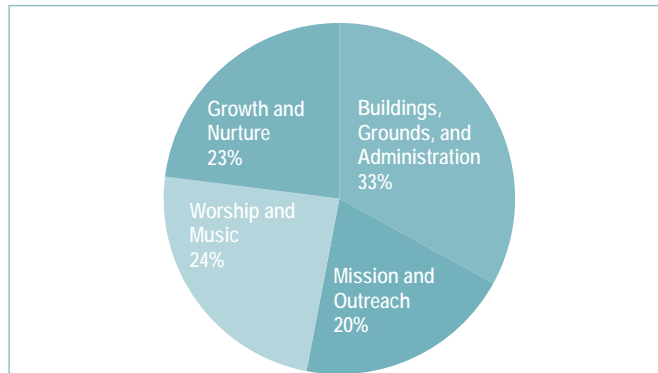


Allocations

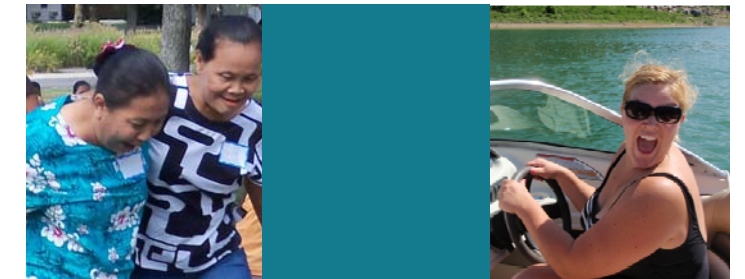
